## Step 1

- Offer active cycle of breathing techniques (ACBT) to individual with bronchiectasis.
- Consider gravity
  assisted positioning
  (where not contraindicated) to enhance
  the effectiveness on
  an airway clearance
  techniques.
  If contraindicated
  then modified postural
  drainage should
  be used.

## Step 2

• If ACBT is not effective or the patients demonstrate poor adherence, oscillating positive expiratory pressures + forced expiration technique should be considered.

## Step 3

• If airway clearance is not effective then nebulised isotonic (0.9% saline) or hypertonic saline (3% saline and above) should be evaluated for its effectiveness pre-airway clearance (especially in patients with viscous secretions or there is evidence of mucus plugging).
